

Tasks of the Council of Graduate Studies at University

1. Studying the suggestions and recommendations of faculties and sending them to deans' council.
2. Approval of Master's thesis proposals submitted by graduate students to their faculties and making appropriate decisions.
3. Approval of forming theses defense committees based on recommendation of deans concerned and making appropriate decisions.
4. Examining the fulfillment of requirements for graduation of Master's students and upon which recommending the awarding of academic degrees.
5. Discussing faculty recommendations of introducing new graduate programs or amending current programs and study plans, and sending recommendations to deans' council.
6. Preparing annual reports about graduate programs at the University based on the reports of faculties concerned.
7. Sending recommendation to the deans' council based on the suggestion of relevant deans regarding the approval of graduate students' examination results.
8. Examining the fulfillment of required conditions of Master's theses prior to approving and setting them at University Library.
