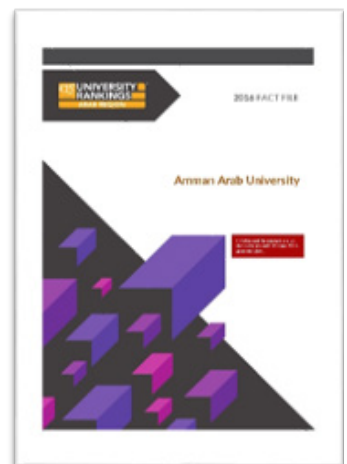

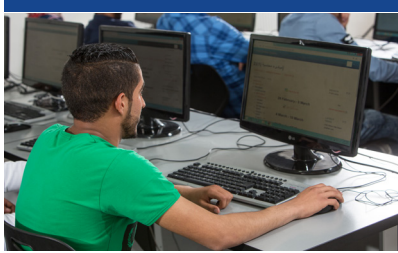

## Monthly Allowance and Accommodation of a Student

The Accommodation sites that University providing to students are in a strategic location in the capital, Amman, where all international restaurants and cafes are located nearby. These areas are also close to Queen Alia International Airport, with a distance not exceeding 20 km.

The cost of living and the monthly allowance for food and drink vary according to the living habits and needs of the student, where the average monthly allowance for food and drink is from US 140 per month.

The University helps to obtain accommodation, by providing offers of accommodation located nearby the services and markets of the University.

These offers vary according to the student's needs, where flats and studios are available for students with double and private systems, at prices of US 155 and 355, with the following specifications:

- Studios consisting of (a room, a large hall, a bathroom and a fully equipped kitchen) Including Internet, T.V, water and services.
- Accommodation is also available for female students with the smart entry system, in addition to amenities and security, supported by cameras and supervisors, equipped with (modern furniture, air conditioners, internet, television, in addition to other essential services).





## Working Hours at the University

The University offers bachelor's and master's programs through regular study, with flexibility to suit wide groups of those wishing to study, especially employees.

First: Working hours for master's students: (with an emphasis on studying at the University as a regular study)

All master's programs at the University offer lectures on one day only, which is Saturday. In other cases, and according to the students' need, some subjects are offered during weekdays after five o'clock in the evening. In all cases, the student can enroll in one of the master's programs, which is on campus on Saturdays only.

Second: Working hours for undergraduate students: (with an emphasis on the fact that study at the University is a regular study)

The university offers two types of lectures for undergraduate programs to suit different segments.

1. Evening lectures: Lectures are offered on Saturday and after four o'clock on weekdays from Sunday to Wednesday. This type of working hours is for the following majors: Business Administration, Human Resources Management, Accounting, Accounting and Business Law, Management Information Systems, Digital Marketing, Finance and Banking, Law, Cyber Security, Mathematics, Special Education.
2. Regular lectures: Lectures for students on weekdays from 8:30-4:00, and the student chooses the suitable time. The University provides this type of lectures for all undergraduate programs offered at the University.





## Transportation and Health Insurance

The University provides transportation for its students to and from the university at a **cost of JD150 per semester**. Also, it provides health insurance **(first class) for its students**.

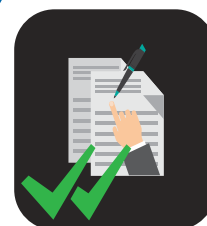

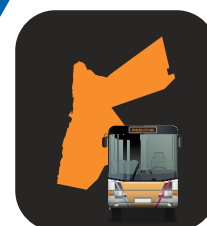

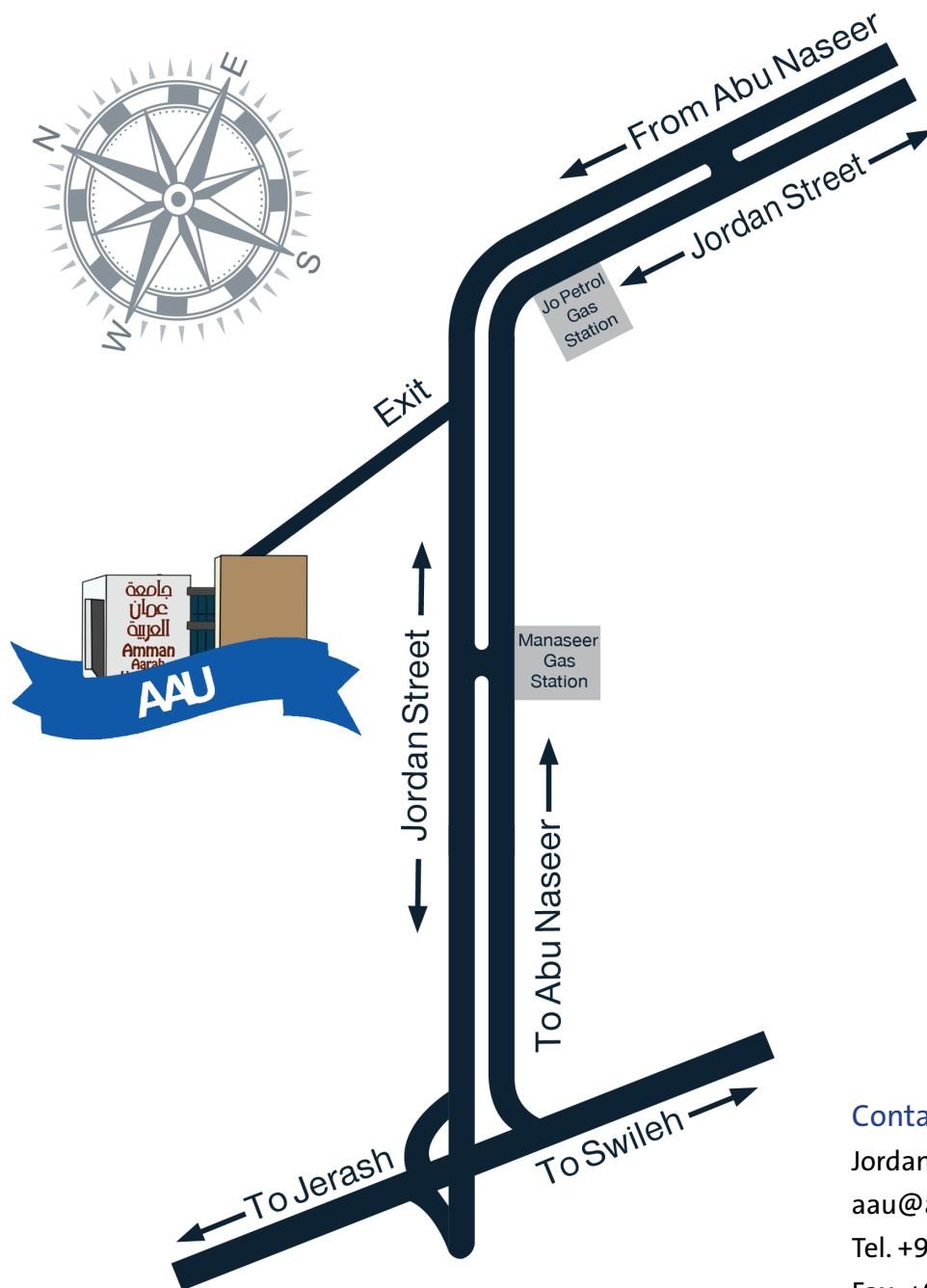
